### News from our sister church in Winnweiler, October 2024:

#### Children's Bible Week

From 7<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> July there were daily sessions for kids on the biblical topic of Jacob and Esau. The kids explored the story through creative projects, theatre, and songs. It ended with a service on 13<sup>th</sup> July where the kids presented their projects.

#### 'Service with Music' in their region:
